Beef Project Fair Worksheet

All 4-H and FFA Beef members must own and/or have in their possession their project animals: Market by March 1, and Breeding by June 1 of the current year. This worksheet will help you identify you animals to remember what you want to enter and if someone else has to enter for you a help to get that done. For the Linn County Fair you will be making your own entries for the fair in the Fair Entry Program (<https://www.fairentry.com>) using your 4Honline profile or FFA School profile. Computer entries will be open **May 10-June 15.**
